

# SUMMERFEST 2008

An integrated camping experience for children with seizure disorders.  
Sponsored by Epilepsy Ontario

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

### Summerfest 2008 Information

To qualify to attend, children (6 to 15 years of age) must want to attend and be able to function independently in the activities of daily living (toilet, washing, dressing, etc.). We have received notice that campers who arrive at camp requiring more than regular cabin supervision and who have not been indicated as requiring mentoring will be sent home at their parents' expense. No fee reimbursement will occur from Camp Couchiching or the Summerfest program in this situation.

Campers attending Summerfest 2008 will have their registration confirmed ONLY after acceptance into the program is granted by the Medical Review Committee of the camp. Initial acceptance will be granted by April 13, 2008.

Regular supervision comprises 2 staff/10 campers 6-12 years of age and 1 staff/10 campers ages 13+. Once again, Epilepsy Ontario is sponsoring additional medical staff during the 12.5 day program.

The fee for 2008 is \$1235.00 (including GST) for two weeks (no campers requiring mentoring). The one week option is available for those who require one-on-one mentoring. The fee for the one week option is \$635.00 plus an additional \$295.00 for one-on-one mentoring.

Registration this year is restricted to 25 campers. Limit of 2 campers requiring mentoring per week. The two week program runs:

3:00 PM June 29 - 10:00 AM July 11, 2008

For those requiring one-on-one mentoring, the program runs:

First week: 3:00 PM June 29 - 10:00 AM July 5, 2008 or

Second week: 3:00 PM July 5 - 10:00 AM July 11, 2008

*Please return all completed forms with deposit and a copy of the camper's health card by March 8, 2008 to ensure registration.*

### Deposit and Final Payment Policy

Registration forms must be accompanied by either the full payment OR the total deposit with a postdated cheque for the balance of the fees. Deposit is \$300.00 per each session of camp.

In the event of family circumstances changing, the deposit will be refunded up to April 13, 2008 less an administration charge of \$20.00 per week attending. Deposit is non-refundable if cancellation is made after May 15, 2008. No fees will be refunded if cancellation is made on or after April 13, 2008 or if the camper fails to attend camp for the entire period of registration for any reason whatsoever including dismissal by the Camp Director, designate or Camp Medical Team Head. Pending approval, a credit note for a portion of the fees may be sent if proper documentation (parent letter and/or doctor's note, depending on the situation) is sent to Epilepsy Ontario.

## **Family Discount**

For 2 or more children from the same family, attending the same 2-week traditional camp period, deduct \$10 each from camp fees.

## **Completed Registration**

Notification will be sent upon acceptance by the Medical Review Committee of Summerfest 2008. In the event of a camper being refused participation within the Summerfest program, a full refund will be sent.

## **Camperships (Financial Assistance)**
